I am pleased to announce the launching of the SLU Tea House under the auspices of the External Relations, Media, and Communications, and Alumni Affairs (ERMCAA) Office. The creation of the SLU Tea House is a result of the university's successful engagement in two Erasmus+ European Union projects: the FRIENDS (<https://erasmusplusfriends.eu/>) and ANTENA (<https://www.antena-project.eu/>).

The SLU Tea House is an integral component of SLU's purposeful integration of intercultural dimensions into the university's formal and informal curricula. It aims to strengthen our internationalization capabilities and to develop our local and international students' global competence. Moreover, the SLU Tea House provides clients (faculty, staff, visitors, and even the alumni) occasions for academic, research, and cultural exchanges. This commitment is also extended to SLU's relevant partner communities to foster cooperation.

Under the SLU Tea House supervision is the International Students Association (ISA) that became operational last 1<sup>st</sup> semester of academic year 2019-2020. As of August 2020, SLU has a total of 127 international students coming from the United States, Angola, United Kingdom, China, Congo, Eritrea, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Jordan, South Korea, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Rwanda, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Timor-Leste, and Yemen. More international students are expected to join us in the future, as initiatives and activities like international exchanges and internships are being rolled out.
