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Project Background

The ERASMUS FRIENDS PROJECT's basis is based on the concept of internationalisation at home (IaH), which shifts the emphasis from outbound to virtual mobility and on-campus intercultural engagement. The purpose of this initiative is to provide direct support for the poor children of Home of Peace Orphanage.

Project Name: KINSHIP

The term kinship refers to a blood familial link. In our case, the blood represents our diversity and familial linkage with the people who are part of our movement. It represents a bond that cannot be severed but built upon with a diverse background, thoughts, and beliefs.

Framework of Action Plan

Integration is a fundamental law of existence; it echoes the past while creating the future through present contribution.

The kinship program looks to create and foster partnerships through its community drawing from the pool of diverse cultures and beliefs available at APU. We aim to provide an environment in which people feel safe, respected, and at ease being themselves and expressing all elements of their identities via lifelong learning, educational, professional, and personal development.

Goals

General goal

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The project's aim is to work with the Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh to build partnerships and provide educational and co-curricular activities, while participating in a fully immersed experience, followed by the Home of Peace Orphanage's and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh integration into the APU community.

We look to take advantage of the APU core curricula course model or to have a community service model implemented in the school that allows students from every intake to provide a service or participate in an ongoing campaign for the selected beneficiary. This way we have a guaranteed number of participants, which in return provides continuous engagement.

Long Term

In the long run, we look to provide school places to individuals from the Home Of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh to either take certification programmes or receive a scholarship to programmes at APU.

Objective

- We seek to enhance students' global competence by incorporating intercultural components into the official and informal curricula of the Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh. This will be accomplished through encouraging and supporting involvement in various activities and sports through a variety of cultural games and activities.
- To help the orphans of Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh develop emotionally, cognitively, and socially through the kinship programme.

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- To foster a positive, loving environment in which the Home of Peace Orphanage's and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh frequently abandoned and neglected children can grow and develop.
- Through education, support, and the development of their self-esteem and social living skills, we hope to rehabilitate the children's interpersonal development skills.
- Aim to supply non-food products to orphans at Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh using funds earned via various events and donations from well-wishers.
- We aim to identify and support creative minds and talented youths who show signs of technological ingenuity hone their skills and becoming productive in their communities.
- We aim to render additional help through a Charity Bazaar event, as well as create an event specifically for the Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh pupils to showcase their talents and skills, thereby continuously integrating the community into APU.
- We strive to uncover and assist creative minds and brilliant youths who demonstrate technological creativity in order for them to hone their abilities and become valuable members of their communities.

Time frame

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Present and forthcoming events

June

- Donations from the venture day were collected from well in the school community to benefit the Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh initiative.
- Officials initiate and hand over funds collected from Venture Day and the baton to the SRC.

July

- Meeting with Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh to understand and clearly outline our objectives and plans
- Open and promote recruitment for volunteers to join a panel.

Aug

- Trial run of the project, gather feedback and review the outcomes.
- Official promotion and awareness building commences to both the student and APU staff regarding the project

September

- The commencement of various educational trips and physical education trips with the goal of improving the children's emotional, mental, and physical health is to be done by students and lecturers.
- The commencement of a service action plan in which various students contribute to the provision of a service other than educational excursions, such as cultural exchange visits

November

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- Invitation of Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh to APU's International Culture Night festival
- Special funding raising performance by the Home of Peace Orphanage and Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh during APU's International Culture Night festival

December

- Podcast interview of the Kinship program hosted by In the Loop podcast featuring Prof Dr Andy Seddon
- Testimonial video from the Home of Peace Orphanage, Rumah Penyayang Anak Yatim dan Asnaf Ulu Yam Selangor - Dar Asnaf Alfateeh and APU students and staff.
